The program will be on “*Tolumnia, Caribbean Jewels*” adapted from the slide program Equitant Oncidium Species prepared by Anita Aldrich and presented by Harriet Davis.

The genus Tolumnia is a diverse group of some 23 or so species and three natural hybrids formerly lumped into the genus Oncidium.



Tolumnia variegata is a miniature species related to Oncidiums that loves plenty of air and warmth. Grow mounted or in an open pot with a little coarse material. Blooms on and off all year; flowers are long-lasting and fragrant.
