Their potting mix was described as the "Can't Fail Mix" and was composed of 2 parts large perlite, 2 parts large charcoal, and 1 part Sunshine Mix, wet and use. This is written on the storage container I use for potting Phalaenopsis, Catasetums, and Cymbidiums. This mix provides airy room around the roots but keeps their fleshy roots moist with the required watering frequency. Any ground peat can probably be used in place of the Sunshine Mix.

Olympia sold many years ago and stock was moved to New York if my less than perfect memory holds. ---- I wonder what happened to the greenhouse. I wish I had such a fabulous one!!! It was large with a high roof of glass and aluminum. Concrete floor with a separate large flasking area with storage and office space. Olympia's hybrid phalaenopsis were flasked and grown there.
